

## INTERNATIONAL GIRLS IN ICT DAY COMPETITION

The International Telecommunications Union (“ITU”) in collaboration with the Office of the Regulator (“OOTR”) will be commemorating its annual ‘Girls in ICT Day’ on Thursday, 23 April 2020 to empower and encourage girls and young women to embrace careers in the growing field of information and communications technology (“ICT”).

### Who:

Girls in Years 12 & 13 from secondary schools are invited to enter OOTR’s Girls in ICT Day Competition.

### Competition Tasks:

This activity will be conducted over the course of four weeks starting from 2 March and ending 27 March 2020. The participants are to attend scheduled sessions held on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday of each week from 3pm – 4pm at OOTR conference room.

The activity is - **Introduction to Coding: Website basics.**

The first two weeks will be dedicated to introductory sessions on the tools utilised for the activity, leaving the last two weeks for the participants to produce their own team product for submission before the due date.

### Terms and Conditions:

- You must complete the Girls in ICT Day Competition Form.
- There is a limited number of participants required, so selection will be based on how well your Form is completed.

- *You can be as creative and imaginative as you need to be, provided you are clear and succinct in addressing the task.*

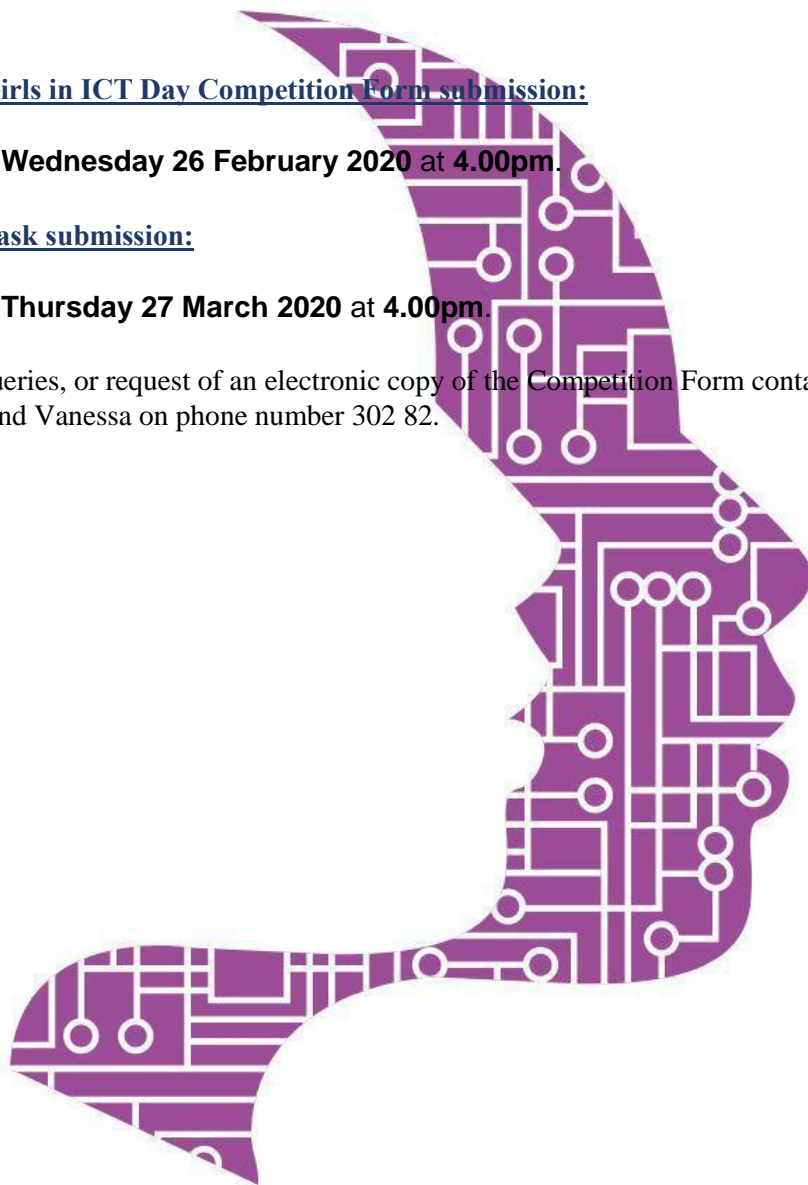
